One (1) \$500.00 Charlie Lecus for Agriculture Scholarship

ELIGIBILITY: Applicant must....

- 1. Be a high school senior residing in the Village of Raymond, or surrounding communities, within Racine County, Wisconsin.
- 2. Have a pending application into an accredited technical, trade school, agricultural program, or college in the year after high school graduation.
- 3. Exhibit scholastic achievement.
- 4. Have been involved in community, church, and or high school extracurricular activities, with an emphasis given to community and church volunteering.
- 5. Have demonstrated good leadership qualities.

APPLICATION PROCESS:

- 1. Complete all three pages (2-4) of this application. Attach additional pages if needed.
- 2. Write a brief essay on "Why I am applying for this scholarship, my reasons for continuing my education, my financial needs, and my future plans.
- 3. Attach a picture with your application suitable for possible publication if chosen.
- 4. Attach a transcript of your high school credits.
- 5. Submit two (2) reference letters stating qualifications for this scholarship from non-relatives. One reference must be from your school (teacher/counselor).
- 6. Submit the application and attachments to the Scholarship Chairperson.
- 7. Applications that are not complete will become ineligible.

DEADLINE: Must be received by **APRIL 15**TH

ANNOUNCEMENT OF WINNERS: Awards Day/Night at your high school and posted to the RCBO website.
